




Female Drivers: More Likely Safer


R.I. Truck Only Tolling Legal Battle

What's in the Infrastructure?

There's a Lot to Celebrate

Authorizes nearly \$973 billion between FY 2022 and FY 2026, including \$550 billion in new federal money for infrastructure projects and existing programs that were set to expire in September

- \$110 billion for roads, bridges, and other major projects
- \$11 billion for transportation safety projects

- Rollback of CA meal and rest break preemption
- Side underride guard mandate
- Hours-of-service rollbacks
- Minimum Insurance increases
- Speed limiters








Truckload Loads

(Index; January 2020 = 100)



Index, January 2020 = 100








Truckload Tractor Counts

LTL Tractor Counts








Retail Diesel Prices


Monthly Averages






Contract Truckload Average Revenue per Mile

Truck Driver Shortage

The driver shortage is bad for many reasons

- ➤ Historical structural causes remain (demographics ie: older drivers, retirements; waiting to be of age, lack of parking & lifestyle)
- > FMCSA's Drug & Alcohol Clearinghouse.
 - As of July 1, 2022 100,279 CDL/CLP holders are in prohibited status with at least 1 violation, with 75,717 of those not starting the return to duty process.


This means, for very good reasons, we need to recruit even more new drivers to the industry.

- ➤ In 2020, pipeline of new drivers is likely less (perhaps much less) schools and DMV's limitations during the pandemic. Back up to 100% capacity now.
- > Some drivers left the industry temporarily or permanently due to the pandemic.
 - Health concerns, pandemic related government assistance and childcare issues

Bottom line: Drivers have left the industry and we have not added enough new drivers. It will take a while to dig out of this supply hole and driver pay will continue to go up as a result.




Truck Driver Shortage

Drivers Needed through 2030







